You are receiving this Notice because records indicate that you may be affected by a copyright infringement lawsuit against Anthropic that is pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California. The lawsuit is called *Bartz v. Anthropic PBC*, No. 3:24-cv-05417-WHA. The Court decided this lawsuit will move forward as a class action—a lawsuit filed on behalf of a group of people—and may include you. This Notice summarizes your rights and options before an upcoming trial on December 1, 2025.

**The Court issued this Notice because Class Members have a right to know about the class action lawsuit against Anthropic and about their legal rights and options before the Court decides the outcome.**

**Who is this lawsuit about?** The lawsuit alleges that Anthropic infringed copyrights by downloading pirated datasets containing copyrighted books, in violation of the federal Copyright Act. Anthropic denies the allegations. The Court has not decided who is right. Anthropic will defend itself at trial. The Court appointed the law firms of Lief Cabraser Heimann & Bernstein, LLP and Susman Godfrey L.L.P. to represent Class Members as Class Counsel. This lawsuit does not affect all potential copyright claims that you may have. Go to [www.xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx.com](http://www.xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx.com) to learn more.

**Who is affected?** Anthropic downloaded millions of books. There is a searchable database of all books covered by the lawsuit at [www.xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx.com](http://www.xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx.com). You are a Class Member if you own the copyright of a book that meets four criteria: (1) it was included in the LibGen or PiLiMi datasets downloaded by Anthropic; (2) it has an ISBN or ASIN; (3) it was registered with the U.S. Copyright Office within 5 years of publication; and (4) it was registered before being downloaded, or within three months of publication. Excluded from the Class are directors, officers, and employees of Anthropic, personnel of federal agencies, and district court personnel.

**What are my options?** You can (1) do nothing, or (2) ask to be excluded (“opt out”).

If you do nothing, you will stay in the Class and be bound by the outcome of this lawsuit. If the Class wins at trial or there is a settlement, you may be eligible to get a payment.

If you opt out, you will **not** be bound by the outcome of this lawsuit. If the lawsuit later results in money or benefits for the Class, you will **not** be eligible to get a payment. But you will keep your right to sue Anthropic in your own lawsuit about the same claims in this lawsuit. **What happens next?** Class Counsel will try to prove the claims against Anthropic at a trial scheduled to start on December 1, 2025. You don't need to attend the trial. Class Counsel will present the case against Anthropic. You or your own lawyer may attend at your own expense.
