# If you own the copyright to a book that was included in the Library Genesis or Pirate Library Mirror datasets downloaded by Anthropic, you may be part of a class action lawsuit



A federal court certified a class action lawsuit against Anthropic PBC for alleged copyright infringement. The lawsuit claims Anthropic downloaded pirated datasets containing copyrighted books. Anthropic denies the allegations. The Court has not decided who is right.

## YOU ARE A CLASS MEMBER IF:

You own the copyright to a book that meets all four criteria:

- ▶ It was included in the LibGen or PiLiMi datasets downloaded by Anthropic
- ▶ It has an ISBN or ASIN
- ▶ It was registered with the U.S. Copyright Office within five years of publication
- ▶ It was registered before being downloaded, or within three months of publication

## YOUR RIGHTS AND OPTIONS

- ▶ **Do Nothing** – Stay in the Class. Be bound by the outcome. You may be eligible for payment if money is recovered from the lawsuit.

- ▶ **Exclude Yourself** (“Opt Out”) – Remove yourself from the Class. You will not be bound by the outcome. You will not be eligible for a payment if money is recovered. This is the only option that allows you to keep your right to sue Anthropic for the claims in this lawsuit. Go to [www.xxx.com](http://www.xxx.com) for more details.
